Background

The majority of parents have the best interests of their child at the heart. However, there is a rare form of child abuse called Fabricated and Induced Illness (FII) where a parent or carer exaggerates or deliberately causes symptoms of illness in a child. This briefing explores this safeguarding issue and multi-agency responses:
